We will go outside for play, fresh air, and to collect acorns, pine cones, seed pods, wildflowers, leaves, berries, and other plant materials we find.

Campers will discuss how plants get themselves ready for winter, and help their animal friends by producing berries and seeds.



We'll talk about how some animals fatten up for winter, such as our own NYC squirrels, who not only eat as many acorns as possible, but also store them!



We'll even examine the jaw structure of rodents and see how squirrels have two sharp top front teeth and two sharp bottom front teeth so that they can chip away at acorn shells.

One project we'll

do is salt dough ornament-making with the natural materials that we pick up.

We'll also make some leaf portraits in various ways: collage, rubbings, and our favorite... layered in splatter paintings!
