



Oct. 5: AMNH Animal Adaptations Scavenger Day

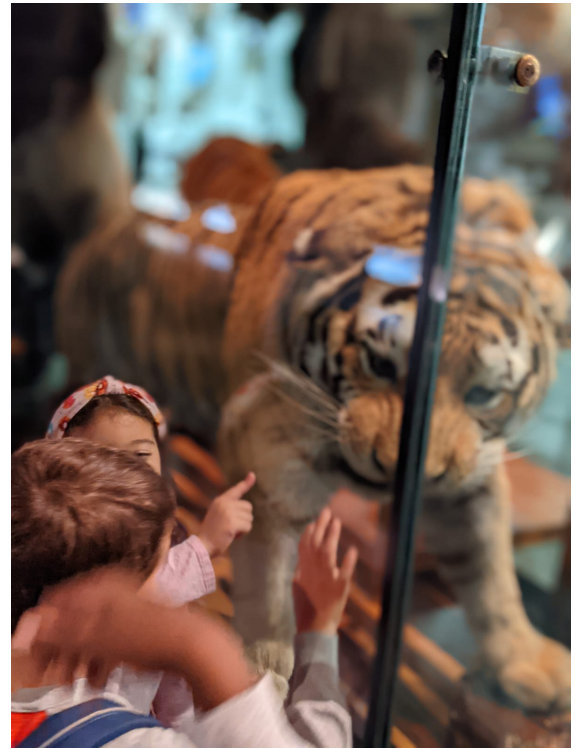
We will pivot to a rain-day plan at the AMNH! (Our planned Smashing Color! outdoor curriculum will be presented in a future camp.) We will visit some popular spots in the museum to get the lay of the land, practice our map-reading skills, pick an animal for closer study, have lunch in the cafeteria, and then launch our fun scavenger hunts in leveled groups.

Campers will follow one of three possible hunts leveled to their group. Some hunts will take them all over the museum, but our main area of focus is the Hall of North American Mammals, where we will learn about some of the adaptations animals have developed for survival. We are focusing specifically on teeth, paws/hooves,

claws, eyes, ears, tails, noses, and fur.

We end up downstairs for an end-of-day snack and “prizes.”

Key language in **French** or **Spanish** includes animal names, body parts, adaptations, habitats, environments, comparison language, seeking and finding, and map language. You will receive a post-camp news sheet with photos, facts and concepts they learned, and a full key vocabulary list.
